



## Information note on the Medical Service

- The school has a medical-nursing service that provides first-time care for students who are injured or suffer from illness **during their stay at school.**
- First aid is guaranteed by two professional nurses during school hours.
- The school doctor is present on the following days:

WEDNESDAY from 10.00 am to 13.00

FRIDAY from 8.40 to 13.00

The doctor has the function of prevention and treatment. For each school year a health check-up is scheduled for each student. Parents will be notified by email and they will also receive a report with any advice.

- The infirmary is located on the ground floor of the ERASMUS building, near the Aula Magna (phone number 0332 806211, e-mail: VAR-MEDCENTRE@eursc.eu).
- Secondary students who need the medical service must first go to the teacher with whom they have lessons at that time, who will insert the word "Sent to infirmary" in the SMS system indicating the time where he sends the boy to the infirmary.
- When a student comes to the medical service, the nurse or doctor evaluates the seriousness of the situation and decides if it's the case to contact the family or call 112. **Those students who arrive in the infirmary, having already contacted by themselves parents to be taken home, are not justified by the medical service.**
- In case of emergency, **anyone who attends a serious event is required first to call 112 and secondly the medical service, that will provide the first aid waiting for the ambulance and advise the family.**



- In the event of absence of more than 3 consecutive days including holidays, medical certification is mandatory to return to school.
- Students returning to school using crutches must present a medical certificate of suitability for admission to the secretary.
- In the event of an accident, parents must send the following documents to the Medical Service:
  - the doctor's certificate or the report of Pronto Soccorso
  - the privacy form (on the website) signed by the parents.

These documents will be sent to the "Assicurazioni Generali" together with the declaration of the school. Otherwise the practice cannot be processed.

- The Medical Service provides, on request, in case of students with chronic diseases (asthma, diabetes, etc.) to the custody of "lifesaving" drugs to administer them in case of need.
- In order to optimize this service, parents are asked to update the medical service regarding the health status of their children (hospital admissions, the onset of new diseases and allergies ...).

#### **CAUTION:**

- **Parents who don't want their children to be given medication should report this to the Medical Service in writing.**
- **For the privacy protection legislation, all medical documentation relating to students must be sent by mail to the medical service or delivered personally by parents or legal guardians directly to the infirmary. (GDPR 2016/679)**
