

We are preparing the safe return of students to school following the instructions of Public Hygiene.

All those who make up the school population (students-families, teachers and staff) must comply with the recommendations to prevent the transmission of the virus.

The success of prevention depends on **EVERYONE's** knowledge and application of these rules.

Students must acquire these correct behaviors and apply them on a daily basis, parents and teachers must help them to apply them at every stage of their "social life", **ALWAYS** and **EVERYWHERE**.

Transmission of new Coronavirus occurs through contact with

- droplets of infected person's saliva generated through cough sneezing;
- contaminated surfaces and subsequent contact with face (eyes, nose, mouth); the virus can survive on surfaces but with a simple disinfection it can be eliminated.

To prevent the spread of the virus it is necessary:

- ⇒ Stay at home if sick or if body temperature outside $> 37.5^{\circ}\text{C}$
- ⇒ Wash your hands often with soap and water (for at least 60 seconds) or alcohol solution (for at least 30 seconds).
- ⇒ Respect the social distancing (at least one meter)
- ⇒ Use the mask indoors and outdoors if the distance of at least one meter cannot be maintained.
- ⇒ Sneeze into the elbow crease or into a paper towel which must be thrown away immediately and then wash your hands.
- ⇒ Clean surfaces and objects frequently with alcohol or chlorinated solution.
- ⇒ Frequently air the premises

These simple practices must be acquired and respected by **EVERYONE** and **EVERYWHERE** and will be the basis of the security of our school community.

In the coming weeks we will send you a range of information, with different versions depending on the age of the students, to help them acquire the right behavior in view of their return to School.
