A Green School is a school that is committed to reducing its impact on the environment and educating its pupils to an active attitude towards protecting the ecosystem.


Green Schools are built on some pillars:



# Introduction



The Green school in Bali was inspired after John and Cynthia Hardy viewed the Al Gore documentary “An Inconvenient Truth”. With their 4 children, the Canadian couple decided to make a difference and, in 2006, broke ground on a new type of school — an educational campus focused on using a holistic teaching approach and a natural canvas as classrooms.

In 2008, the school had 90 students enrolled and this has now reached 500!


# Localisation



The Green School is located on 20 acres in south central Bali - Indonesia.

The campus emerged from the jungle and rice fields. Using local architects and materials, mainly bamboo, they spent 2 years constructing an open-air campus, which now houses several hundred students and teachers.

All of the structures are built primarily from bamboo, a local, natural, renewable resource.



# Education

The goal of that school is to educate young people from over the world (from from 3 to 18 years) in a natural environment which will inspire them to become creative, innovative and green people. The location of the Green school in an undeveloped and natural area is an ideal place for students to connect with nature.





# Program

# Why « Green »?

- Natural construction: using green materials for an eco-friendly design
- Vegetarian school lunches: most of the meals provided are grown on campus

- Solar energy and vortex hydropower from the river generate electricity.
