

- 1. Pupil taken away from school for symptomatology or absent for symptomatology who carried out the diagnostic swab research for SarsCoV 2:**
 - ⇒ Return to school with negative swab and doctor's certificate that the pupil has followed the COVID-19 diagnostic, therapeutic and prevention treatment.

- 2. Positive diagnostic swab for Sars-CoV-2 and clinically cured:**
 - ⇒ Return to school with negative swab and doctor's certificate to come back to the community.

- 3. Close contact established case that has always been asymptomatic:**
 - ⇒ Return to school with negative result of swab on the tenth day of quarantine (STRONGLY RECOMMENDED OPTION) or, at the end of the 14 days of quarantine, with certificate received from ATS + statement by legal guardians that the pupil has remained asymptomatic during this period.

- 4. In all cases of absence due to illness exceeding 2 days not attributable to COVID-19:**
 - ⇒ Return with medical certificate¹.

Article 30 3. d) ii: "***After an absence of more than two days, primary and secondary pupils will only be allowed to return to school on production of a doctor's certificate presented by the pupil's legal representatives***".
