<p><b>Suspected case</b> with diagnostic swab <b>NEGATIVE</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>STATEMENT</b> by the treating doctor that the child can be readmitted to the community because the diagnostic, therapeutic and preventive course for Covid-19 has been performed</li> <li>• <b>NEGATIVE SWAB RESULT</b></li> </ul>
<p><b>Suspected case</b> with diagnostic swab <b>POSITIVE</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>STATEMENT</b> by the treating doctor of suitability to return to the community <u>ONLY</u> after virological and clinical recovery</li> <li>• <b>END OF ISOLATION CERTIFICATE</b> issued by ATS or <b>NEGATIVE TAMPON RESULT</b></li> </ul>
<p>Case that turns out to be due to <b>NON-COVID PATHOLOGY</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In case of absence of more than 2 days <b>CERTIFICATE</b> of good health by the treating doctor, as per regulation of the European Schools</li> </ul>

### **ACCORDING INDICATIONS FOR REOPENING OF SCHOOLS...**

**ATS INSUBRIA REV, 02 DATE OF AGG.17-22/09/2020 point 6 page 11/22...**

**The return of the child will take place in accordance with the ordinary procedures in use in the school itself, if necessary, only if expressly indicated by the school, with a declaration of the parents concerning the reasons for the absence.**

...

**Therefore, the European School of Varese refers to the GENERAL RULES OF THE EUROPEAN SCHOOLS (2014-03-D-14-en-9) which in this regard reads:**

#### **Article 30 3. d) ii:**

"After an absence of more than two days, primary and secondary school students will only be able to return to school upon presentation of a medical certificate by the pupil's legal guardian"

All documentation shall be sent to Medical Service ([VAR-MEDCENTRE@eursc.eu](mailto:VAR-MEDCENTRE@eursc.eu)) the day before your return.
