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<p>Symptomatic student in self-monitoring or taken out of school</p> <p>Perform a test IMMEDIATELY (self-test or antigenic or molecular test) and if negative but symptoms persist repeat after 5 days (*)</p>	<p>SELF-CERTIFICATION stating negativity to self-testing</p> <p style="text-align: center;">or</p> <p>NEGATIVE RESULT OF CERTIFIED ANTIGENIC OR MOLECULAR SWAB</p>
<p>POSITIVE case (certified by antigenic or molecular test) (*)</p>	<p>END OF ISOLATION CERTIFICATE issued by ATS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">or</p> <p>NEGATIVE RESULT OF CERTIFIED ANTIGENIC OR MOLECULAR SWAB 7 days after positive swab for fully vaccinated subjects, 10 days after positive swab for unvaccinated subjects</p>
<p>NON-COVID PATHOLOGIES</p>	<p>No medical certificate/attestation is required (the obligation to justify any absence remains).</p> <p>The School(through the Medical Service) reserves the right to request a medical certificate/attestation declaring illness after absence due to illness of more than:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3 days for the nursery cycle; - 5 days for the primary and secondary cycle.
<p>(*) <i>N.B.</i> <i>A positive self-test does not constitute a diagnosis but must be confirmed by a certified antigenic or molecular test (DL 24/2022)</i></p>
