

Original version IT	DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO RETURN TO SCHOOL AFTER ILLNESS
	The positive pupil may return with a negative official test result to be sent to the Medical Service (VAR-MEDCENTRE@eursc.eu), to the absence service (cycle/year) and to the transport service (if used) in order to be readmitted to school.
Pupil absence for official COVID POSITIVE test(*)	A positive pupil who has been totally asymptomatic for at least two days may return to school 5 days after the positive result without a swab but with a written declaration by the legal guardians of the absence of symptoms in the last two days to the Medical Service (VAR-MEDCENTRE@eursc.eu), to the absences service (cycle/year) and to the transport service (if used). In this case the pupil MUST WEAR THE FFP2 MASK until the tenth day after the positive result or until the official test is negative.
Pupil absence for NON-COVID PATHOLOGIES	No medical certificate/attestation is required (the obligation to justify any absence remains). The School(through the Medical Service) reserves the right to request a medical certificate/attestation declaring illness after absence due to illness of more than: - 3 days for the nursery cycle; - 5 days for the primary and secondary cycle.
(*) N.B. A positive self-test does not constitute a diagnosis but must be confirmed by a certified antigenic or molecular test (DL 24/2022)
