<u>APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS</u>

- Have an appropriate teaching qualification: diploma (validated by the national authorities)
 permitting to teach in the Nursery/Primary school -PGCE and QTS would be considered as an
 asset.
- Recent experience teaching to Nursery/Primary school pupils.
- Being able to work in a dynamic, multilingual and multicultural team.
- Passion for teaching and taking into account all of the child's competences, beyond purely academic aspects.
- Interest in and practicing differentiating pedagogy.
- A high level of professionalism and care for the pupils' well-being.
- European citizen or person having a valid working permit in Italy.

PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO A TEACHER WHO:

- Has experience teaching in a European or international school.
- Integrates new technologies as pedagogical tools.
- Speaks another vehicular language (FR DE) or Italian, as language of the host country. This will be considered an asset.
- Is flexible in the schedule.



WE OFFER

We are offering contracts in accordance with the Service regulations for the locally recruited teachers in the European schools (Ref.: 2016-05-D-11-en-7) available on the EE website: www.eursc.eu

Starting day: as soon as the new class is made up.

Schedule: you will be teaching classes between Monday and Friday; as well as time required for related duties, team meetings (follow-up of students, setting up of shared projects), and meeting with parents

Type of contract: contract till the end of the school year (renewable) in accordance with the Service regulation for the locally recruited teachers in the European schools.

Salary: monthly gross salary (approximatively) of 3109,60 (around 24 hours per week). 13 salaries per year.

School fees: for school year teachers, a reduction in school fees shall be granted during the period of their employment for any of their children enrolled in the European Schools. (cfr: article 39 of the Service regulations).

Removal costs: in accordance to the Service regulations, the locally recruited teachers recruited for a minimum period of one year and a contract providing a minimum of 16 hours/periods per week, are entitled to reimbursement of their removal expenses unless the contract ends within the first 12 months due to circumstances lying in their responsibility (cfr: article 37 & 38 of the Service regulations).

Installation allowance: A locally recruited teacher recruited for a minimum period of one year and a contract providing a minimum of 16 hours/periods per week who furnishes evidence of having been obliged to change his/her place of residence and of having actually settled at his/her place of employment in order to comply with Article 27 of the Service Regulations shall be entitled to an installation allowance (cfr: article 27 & 37bis of the Service regulations).
