- Have an appropriate teaching qualification: **diploma (validated by the national authorities) permitting to teach in the Nursery/Primary school and possibly also in the Secondary school** too. Being a native speaker will be considered an asset.
- Recent experience teaching Nursery/Primary school pupils and/or Secondary students.
- Being able to work in a dynamic, multilingual and multicultural team.
- A deep commitment to teaching that considers all aspects of a child's abilities, extending beyond just academic achievements.
- Interest in and practicing differentiating pedagogy.
- A high level of professionalism and care for the pupils' well-being.
- **European citizen or person having a valid working permit in Italy.**

PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO A TEACHER WHO:

- Has experience teaching in a European or international school.
- Integrates new technologies as pedagogical tools.
- Speaks another vehicular language (FR – EN - DE) and/or Italian. This will be considered an asset.
- Demonstrate flexibility with scheduling.

We are offering contracts in accordance with the Service regulations for the locally recruited teachers in the

Starting day: 01.09.2025

Schedule: you will be teaching classes between Monday and Friday; as well as time required for related duties, team meetings (follow-up of students, setting up of shared projects), and meeting with parents.

Type of contract: one year contract (renewable) in accordance with the Service regulation for the locally recruited teachers in European schools.

Salary: monthly gross salary (*approximately*) of 1477,00 euros (3,75 hours per week in Primary + 4 periods of 45 minutes in Secondary), **net 1091,00 euros**. In Italy we offer “tredicesima”, that is **13 salaries per year**.

Location: Varese, Italy

Note: In addition to teaching Slovene as a first language (L1), additional teaching assignments may be allocated based on the school's needs at the start of the academic year, as well as the selected candidate's qualifications and professional experience.

Additional info related to the contract: the contract includes additional benefits—such as school fees, removal costs, installation allowance, and others—which may vary according to the candidate's family composition and the number of hours stipulated in the contract.
