APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

- Have an appropriate teaching qualification: diploma (validated by the national authorities) permitting to teach in the Nursery/Primary school.
- Recent experience teaching to Nursery/Primary school pupils.
- Being able to work in a dynamic, multilingual and multicultural team.
- Passion for teaching and taking into account all of the child's competences, beyond purely academic aspects
- Interest in and practicing differentiating pedagogy
- A high level of professionalism and care for the pupils' well-being
- European citizen or person having a valid working permit in Italy.

PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO A TEACHER WHO:

- Has experience teaching in a European or international school
- Integrates new technologies as pedagogical tools
- Speaks vehicular languages (EN - FR - DE) or Italian, as language of the host country. This will be considered an asset.
- Is flexible in the schedule.



WE OFFER

We are offering contracts in accordance with the Service regulations for the locally recruited teachers in the European schools (Ref.: 2016-05-D-11-en-7) available on the official site website of the European Schools: www.eursc.eu

Starting day : as soon as possible, throughout the current school year.

Schedule: Maltese classes between Monday and Friday (90 mins per week for a child in P2; 90 mins per week for a child in P4); as well as time required for related duties, team meetings (follow-up of students, setting up of possible shared projects), and meeting with parents.

Salary: Monthly gross salary of €435.30, corresponding to an approximate net amount of €390 (assuming no additional duties or supervision are assigned). Payment is made in 13 installments per year.

Type of contract : one year contract (renewable) in accordance with the Service regulation for the locally recruited teachers in the European schools.

Location : Varese, Italy

Additional info related to the contract: the contract includes additional benefits—such as school fees, removal costs, installation allowance, and others—which may vary according to the candidate's family composition and the number of hours stipulated in the contract.

Alternative Type of contract: It would be possible to implement **remote teaching** delivered by a teacher residing abroad, ideally in the country of the target language, namely Malta. In this case, the school would establish an agreement with the teacher, and a different remuneration scheme would apply, in accordance with the regulations governing European schools.
